The proposed house will be two and one-half story, 3,393 square feet in area and approximately 28'-6" in height. The cities masonry requirement is not applicable for the proposed home. The design elements are provided as follows:

Front Façade – 3 Elements Needed

- Multiple Roof Lines
- Multiple Materials Used
- Decorative architectural elements
- At Least three windows provided
- Recesses/offsets

Right Side – 2 Elements Needed

• Multiple Roof Lines

### Left Side – 2 Elements Needed

- Recesses/offsets

The colors are as follows:

- Lap Siding: White
- Board & Batten: Light Gray
- Roof: Metal Standing Seam Gray

Caitlin Keefe of 511 Leonard Avenue, neighbor to 545 Leonard Avenue, brought up safety concerns of developing the site. Soil stability was a concern with a previous potential development of the property. The site geotech report will be followed and adjusted as needed based upon soil conditions found. Site development should not impact adjacent properties.

7. Site Plan Review for a new residence at 545 Leonard Avenue

City Planner Ellen Rottjakob reviewed the request submitted by Jessica Deem architect representing property owners Nate & Allison Brack for a new residence at 545 Leonard Avenue. The proposed house will be two and one-half story, 3,393 square feet in area and approximately 28'-6" in height. The cities masonry requirement is not applicable for the proposed home. The property is zoned "A" Residence District. The property is currently vacant. The land will be graded to maintain the current drainage pattern.
